Notice is hereby given that The Village of Hudson Falls, New York has adopted “The Village of Hudson Falls Fair Housing Law”, a local law prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status or national origin in the sale, lease, rental, advertising, financing, or brokerage of housing. A Fair Housing Officer has also been appointed to provide the public with information about the Fair Housing Act.
