Crossing Guard

The Village of Hudson Falls is seeking applications to fill a part-time/per diem, school calendar year, Crossing Guard positions. Crossing Guards are responsible for assisting students in crossing roadways at designated crosswalks and assisting with the flow of traffic from the school buildings. Work is performed independently with only occasional directions from a superior. Crossing Guards must be able to work during inclement weather and hold a stop sign at an elevated position during the course of the shift.

Location and Shifts:

Location one: Intermediate School, Maple Street crosswalk

Shift 1: Morning 8:15 – 9:15

Shift 2: Afternoon 3:10 – 4:10

Location two: High School, Main Street crosswalk

Shift 1: Morning 7:15 – 8:15

Shift 2: Afternoon 2:00 – 3:00

*Hours may vary slightly depending on traffic volume.

Rate of Pay: \$31.29 per location/per shift

Depending on availability and scheduling needs, a Crossing Guard may have the flexibility to cover multiple shifts in a day and be compensated accordingly.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must be at least 18 years old.

Personal transportation to report to multiple work posts, if required.
